Your Excellences, Ladies and Gentlemen,

Greetings from the Arab Hospitals Federation,



The chairman of the jury for the AHF gold Initiative certificate is pleased to put in your hands the recommendations of the Healthcare sustainability paper launched by the Federation simultaneously with The 2022 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP27) held in Sharm El-Sheikh from 6 to 18 November 2022, which set its goals and recommendations to serve the Arab Healthcare sector, hoping that it will meet your expectations and receive your appreciation and support.

This week, The 2022 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP27) started its discussions and negotiations in Sharm El-Sheikh - Egypt to save the planet and all life on it from the catastrophic consequences of climate change.

This important Conference must find ways to address the climate crisis in a realistic and comprehensive manner in order to fulfill the terms of the 2015 Paris Agreement against a turbulent global background shaped by many geopolitical & economical crises.

Countries will assess progress towards the agreed goal of limiting global warming to 1.5°C above pre-industrial levels. Achieving the goals has enormous benefits for human health as climate action must be placed in the context of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which must be achieved without delay by 2030 as agreed by world leaders at a special United Nations conference in September 2015.

Unfortunately, the crisis has only gotten worse since than according to the latest report from the UN Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), the world continues to deviate by an alarming degree from its emissions reduction targets, instead of a 45 percent drop by 2030, the emissions will increase about 14 percent.

Climate change is a growing health threat around the world contributing in many problems and the healthcare industry is part of the problem as researches show that Health sector contributes to the global climate crisis and the Hospitals and all Healthcare services must play a dynamic role in leading Healthcare towards sustainability.

Globally, air pollution causes seven million preventable deaths each year, and high heat causes another five million. In addition to responding to the effects of the climate catastrophe, health systems are also accountable for gigatonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent, or 4-5% of all worldwide net emissions and Hospitals & pharmaceutical companies are the largest drivers of emissions, in addition to the impact of medical waste, unsustainable materials and anesthetics used in surgery, which are greenhouse gases.



When I was Nominated as the chairman of the Jury of the Gold Initiative certificate of: "The Arab Healthcare Climate Change Challenge Champion" launched by the Arab Hospitals Federation, my aim was through this ambitious initiative to drive hospitals' role in creating incentives for change, fostering healthy communities, enhancing environmental impact, supporting the economy and promoting innovative models of care, as well in spreading & implementing the Strategy of the "new vision for Healthcare facility design" launched by AHF following Covid - 19 pandemic that promotes green, smart, safe, and Resilient Hospitals...

Climate change, health, and health equity are inextricably linked, and I was inspired by the thoughtful contributions from leaders in the world who understand the importance of addressing these issues together. The design of eco-friendly, energy-efficient, and green construction projects is gaining care especially in the hospitals field. The "Green Hospital" concept leads the healthcare facilities to redefine how these facilities are built to protect the environment while saving human lives.

In the Arab Hospitals Federation, we believe that joining efforts with the Arab ministries of Health, Healthcare bodies & organizations and the various stakeholders is essential to face this new challenge, as well to commit and encourage Healthcare leaders in driving this transformation will let us reach the goal to confront this crisis and spare the patients, hospitals, health systems and community from its consequences.

This is exactly what we learned from Covid -19 pandemic that has had a profound impact on humanity and the world economy in 2020, and it has taught us that it is possible for the world to come together for an important cause.

From our side, and after what we went through during Covid-19 pandemic and witnessed the challenges of healthcare facilities in facing the crisis in all aspects especially the flexibility of hospital design to accommodate patients infected and non-infected in addition to many other problems, the AHF launched in 2022 the strategy of the "new vision for Healthcare facilities design" that aims to play an important role in setting a new approach for building design & construction in which it addresses the impact of the climate crisis on the health sector in order to reach the Sustainable Development Goals 3, 7 and 13.

As well it launched the Gold Initiative in its new edition under the theme of the Arab Healthcare Climate Change Challenge Champion in which we received a huge numbers of submissions from the Arab Healthcare Institutions that showed us through their papers and projects a good model and excellent example for Healthcare sustainability in our Arab Countries.

Therefore, and in the occasion of the COP 27 conference that is held in Egypt this year and COP 28 conference to be held next year in Abu Dhabi, we are all committed to contribute to save our planet and to encourage our Healthcare facilities to confront the challenge and to spread the Awareness and the culture of Healthcare sustainability in Arab world.



In line with all the efforts deployed today at COP27, and on based on all the points mentioned in the strategy of the new vision for the healthcare facilities design and through the gold initiative certificate, we submit here below to your Excellency through this paper, the most important recommendations presented to the Arab Healthcare sector on which we will work hardly with all stakeholders to implement:

- Encouraging dialogue with all stakeholders to adopt an environmental sustainability policy for health systems.
- Creating unique, comprehensive and reliable Healthcare Sustainability framework for Healthcare Institutions and Health sector that will promote sustainability, effectiveness of care, accountability, and encourage the Healthcare facilities to protect the environment while saving human lives.
- Assessing the Arab Healthcare Institutions in Public & Private sector by our experts according to the Healthcare Sustainability framework to have a future green Health.
- Increasing the awareness campaign on Healthcare sustainability.
- Committing leaders and developing their leadership skills to respond effectively to climate change.
- Engaging the health workforce as an advocate of sustainability.
- Boosting innovation and encouraging investments in healthcare sustainability by building green hospitals, Managing Healthcare & Pharma waste, Reducing Water Consumption, using alternative sources of energy and others ...
- Leading the efforts in the development of Energy Efficiency & Renewable energy to help Healthcare Institutions to implement it.
- Reducing stress on patients, staff & visitors by using Natural lights and the green areas around hospitals which have a therapeutic impact through the architectural and landscape design.
- Promote sustainable procurement through an efficient supply chain.
- Initiating cooperation and partnerships between the various stakeholders to face this challenge.
- Bring world class solutions and ideas to the Healthcare Sector to move towards green hospital.

We will work hard with your Excellency on all these topics, to implement them and follow them, and we are confident that the above mentioned issues will undoubtedly be raised in the context of the wide program of the Sharm el-Sheikh COP27 that Egypt planned, in which the healthcare officials present in COP 27 will have the greatest impact especially that the Director General of the World Health Organization Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus expressed the need to urge leaders and policy makers together to put health at the center of negotiations and to fulfill their pledges.

Egypt has worked closely with the five economic regions of the United Nations, Climate Pioneers and specialized financial and advisory institutions to prepare lists of projects that deserve investment and financing and of course the health care sector was one of the main priorities.

Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC)



Hamad Medical Corporation (HMC) is the main provider of secondary and tertiary healthcare in Qatar and one of the leading hospital providers in the Middle East. For more than four decades, HMC has been dedicated to delivering the safest, most effective and compassionate care to all its patients.

HMC manages thirteen hospitals well as the National Ambulance Service and home and residential care services.

In May 2019, HMC achieved its greatest international accreditation success to date with thirteen of its facilities and services accredited by US-based Joint Commission International (JCI). This included accreditation for the first time for three new hospitals as well as the Hamad Dental Center and Mental Health Service. This represents the greatest number of JCI accredited facilities in Qatar to date and the culmination of HMC's largest ever hospital accreditation program.

HMC also remains the only hospital system outside of the United States to achieve corporate Academic Medical Center accreditation for all its hospitals simultaneously.

Additionally, the National Ambulance Service, Home Healthcare Service, Stroke Service and Palliative Care, have all received this prestigious accreditation since 2011.

To meet the needs of a rapidly growing population, HMC has announced ambitious plans to expand capacity across its network through to 2030.

HMC is leading the development of the region's first academic health system - combining innovative research, top-class education and excellent clinical care - and is committed to building a legacy of healthcare expertise in Qatar. HMC collaborates with key partners who are experts in Qatar and beyond, including Weill Cornell Medical College-Qatar, the Institute for Healthcare Improvement and Partners Healthcare, Boston.

HMC is also the first hospital system in the Middle East to achieve institutional accreditation from the Accreditation Council of Graduate Medical Education – International (ACGME-I), which demonstrates excellence in the way medical graduates are trained through residency, internship and fellowship programs.







According to the World Health Organization (WHO), of the total amount of waste generated by Healthcare activities globally, about 85 percent is general, non-hazardous waste, much of which can be recycled.

In line with the Qatar National Vision 2030 and its commitment to environmental sustainability, HMC is committed to working to reduce the general waste we send to landfills in Qatar every year. We are doing this by making practical and achievable changes.

As part of meeting this goal, for the first phase of this four-phase program, we installed an innovative recycling system in selected areas of HMC with a commitment to roll this our across our organization.

We also worked to create a culture of change - that is to promote environmental awareness and accountability amongst our staff and the community. This included educating staff and our patients about the importance of taking sustainable measures such as these and partnering with external organizations to help us achieve this.





Egypt Healthcare Authority

Egypt's Constitution of 2014 has clearly stated the importance of health and environment, referring to such as human rights, and denoting that Every citizen has the right to health and to comprehensive health care with quality standards, and that every individual has the right to live in a healthy, sound and balanced environment. The protection of such rights is a national duty, and the state is committed to taking all necessary measures to protect and prevent the violation of those rights, and rationalize the utilization of available natural resources in order to achieve the goals of sustainable development, and protect the rights of future generations.

Political support provided by the Constitution, has enormously empowered policy makers to put these constitutional aspirations into action, by developing Egypt's Sustainable Development Strategy 2030, with a great focus on health. The health pillar included in this strategy emphasized the establishment of Universal health coverage, and the right of the whole population for equal and fair access to healthcare services.

Accordingly, the Law of Universal Health Insurance was issued in 2018 and consequently the relative regulations. The Law is marked as a road map for a new era that entails drastic health reforms related to all aspects of healthcare service providing. Such reforms include fundamental institutional, functional and regulatory restructuring, applying governance principles in separating finance from service provision, and ensuring equitable and equal access for all citizens to obtain proper healthcare services.

Under UHI Law, new entities were established, as following:

- 1. UHIA: Universal Health Insurance Authority: responsible for health services financing (revenue collection, pooling, and strategic purchasing)
- 2. EHA: (Egypt Healthcare Authority): responsible for healthcare provision along with adjusting and regulating service provision.
- 3. GAHAR: (General Authority for healthcare accreditation and regulation): responsible for accreditation and technical regulations.

Egypt Healthcare Authority is the public provider of healthcare services under the Law of Universal Health Insurance in Egypt. So far, Healthcare facilities in four Governorates were affiliated to EHA, with the total of 156 healthcare facilities; 134 Primary Healthcare facilities and 21 hospitals, and one polyclinic, and total workforce of around 17500 employees. Among the previously mentioned facilities, 108 healthcare facilities are registered and accredited by GAHAR, whose standards are derived from the international standards of ISQWA.

Since it's known that the climate footprint of healthcare facilities is responsible for Approximately 5% of net global emissions, and that climate change, chemical pollution and the irrational use of resources in the health sector exacerbate health problems in the world and negatively affect public health, not to mention, the political leadership that is providing all the support needed for confronting climate change impacts.

In this respect and coinciding with Egypt's hosting the Conference of the Parties on Climate Change at its twenty-seventh session (COP 27) in November 2022, and going with the presidential commitment toward Living Green, and the signing of the document of Sharm El-Sheikh as a green city by the Ministry of Environment, along with UNDP, and complying with Egypt's Sustainable
